## Guide to local community transport schemes in Essex

This booklet provides information on community based transport schemes in operation throughout Essex, including local social car schemes, dial a ride and minibus services. You will also find information on local shopper bus services, Disability Essex and Essex County Council's Community Link, which provide many services of their own.

A community based transport scheme is normally a non-profit making system of providing transport for people with restricted mobility or for those living in isolated areas not served by conventional public transport. Many of these schemes rely on voluntary help and are always looking for volunteers.

The schemes within this booklet have been grouped by the district or borough in which they operate. The information is correct at time of going to press but is subject to change. We recommend that you contact the scheme for up to date information and fares. In many cases booking is required before you travel.

## Concessionary Passes

If you live in England and are an older person or an eligible disabled person, you are entitled to a concessionary bus pass allowing free off-peak local bus travel (that's 0930 until 2300 Monday – Friday and all day at weekends and bank holidays) anywhere in England. Essex, Southend and Thurrock Passholders can travel in the administrative area of Essex County Council Southend and Thurrock from 0900 to midnight.

Some Community Transport schemes and shopper buses will accept Concessionary Bus Passes; in these instances we have mentioned this in the introductory text of valid schemes.

From 1 April 2011, Essex County Council will be responsible for administering the Concessionary Pass scheme for Essex. Your local district/borough council office will continue to be responsible for processing applications and issuing passes.

The age of eligibility changed on 6 April 2010. For further information contact your local district or borough council.

## Taxis

Taxi services provide a demand responsive service that fills the gaps between regular local bus services and the rail network.

Many areas are served by accessible taxi services. For information on local taxi firms please consult your local business listings directory, such as Yellow Pages and the Thompson Local.

We also ensure they are safe and supported throughout this time by providing compulsory basic training and extensive safety training and protective clothing.

### How it works

Young people are referred by Connexions or they can apply themselves to join the scheme. They are then interviewed by the Catch22 ZBikes project worker to assess their needs and suitability. Each young person receives compulsory basic training and safety training, including road safety.

The young people are then issued with safety equipment including a helmet, jacket, gloves and waterproof trousers. A monthly fee and refundable deposit is applicable.

## Farnham – Bishop’s Stortford (Service 19)
