Inspection Results Summary:

- The 'implementation area' of extraction has been completed as per ESS/28/23/TEN. Vehicles, machinery and welfare unit have been removed from site (Cond 71).
- Topsoil and subsoil storage bunds are in position along the northern and western boundaries as per drawing ref 01RevC (09/23).
- The depth of extraction is deeper than anticipated (between 4m-up to 6m) but above the water table.
- It was stated on site that 20,000tonnes in total has been extracted.
- The silt lagoon area and 'as-raised' mineral are in the correct position as per drawing ref 01RevC (09/23).
- The internal route for soil storage was along the internal tracks as per the drawing. Large plant (1 movement in, 1 movement out) used a direct N-S route from Englishes Farm into the extraction area.
- The applicant should not now be using the Englishes Farm access.
- A gap has been made through the hedge to allow access as per the plans. A bat bridge has not been installed and must be completed asap for compliance with Condition 12.
- Highways approvals are awaited with regard to the highway works and main access route from the B1028 required by the s106 Agreement.
- For the next phase of development, the applicant is reminded that prior notification of soil stripping is required under Condition 54 and 39 (noise).
- Condition 59 requires the submission of an Annual Soils Audit at the end of each calendar year.
- Condition 63 requires the submission of a post-excavation assessment for archaeology.

Scope of Condition and Action to be taken: Post-excavation assessment for archaeology.

Action to be taken by Operator or MPA/WPA: Submission by operator within 12 months of archaeological fieldwork

Permission/Condition No: ESS/28/23/TEN s106 Agreement.

Scope of Condition and Action to be taken: Liaison meeting.

Action to be taken by Operator or MPA/WPA: Operator to arrange first meeting in January 2024 (has been delayed due to availability of attendees).

Actions to be taken before next site visit:

- Submission of outstanding conditions as per details set out in the report.
- Operator to keep MPA informed of progress with highway approvals etc so that the start date of the next phase is known in advance.
- Liaison meeting to be arranged and implemented.
