Actions from last site visit:

• None.

Inspection Results Summary:

- No mineral has been extracted since last visit. No machinery or extraction was taking place at time of visit. Deadline for completing reservoir 1 had been extended by 18 months to July 2025 as per permission ESS/101/21TEN.
- Works were taking place preparing the site in advance of commencement of second reservoir. Works taking place within the red line boundary of reservoir 1 only. Works included laying tarmac for car-parking area and HGV route into the site, construction of weighbridge, and the beginning of the declined haul road which will traverse 2m down into the site processing area.
- Regarding the existing reservoir void, only a couple of metres of sand remaining above the London clay to be extracted, circa 100,000 tonnes left to be extracted by July 2025.
- Pump was examined which pumps out water to Bentley Brook when natural water table raises the water level within the quarry void.
- Land drain was running into void operator reported that it needs to be diverted which will be arranged with the landowner.

Actions to be taken before next site visit:

• Complete extraction of mineral and progress towards site restoration by July 2025 deadline.
