ESS/80/20/TEN – Continuation of quarry restoration to part agriculture, part nature conservation and part open water, without compliance with conditions 1 (approved plans), 44 (landscape scheme), 49 (completion by 30th June 2020), 50 (restoration by 30th June 2020) and 53 (Construction Environment Management Plan) attached to planning permission ref ESS/43/19/TEN to allow for an extension of time to complete restoration and for the permanent retention of the access onto Alresford Road.

Actions from last site visit:

- Alresford Road access works to be finalised and submitted for approval.
- Ponded area alongside Keelars Lane restored tunnel to be regularised.

Inspection Results Summary:

- Alresford Road access works have not progressed. Tarmac are still undecided as to the scheme they want to implement. This does need to be finalised as a matter of priority.
- The ponded area alongside the Keelars Lane restored tunnel is in place but has not been regularised.
- The site generally was holding a lot of water, with some areas flooded.
- The site has varying sizes of debris across the restored surface. Permission ref ESS/80/20/TEN requires no debris larger than 15cm in diameter. Stones should be picked across such that this is adhered to.

Actions to be taken before next site visit:

- Alresford Road access works to be finalised and implemented.
- Ponded area alongside Keelars Lane restored tunnel to be regularised.
- Surface stones to be picked.
- Tarmac to ensure that all seeding and planting has been carried out in accordance with the restoration plan, prior to the first aftercare visit.

Note: The actions noted in this report are required in order to ensure adequate progress is made and to avoid potential enforcement action against a breach of planning control.
