Inspection results summary:

An area to the north of cell 1 remains to be restored (soiled and profiled) however the operator is hopeful that this work will be able to be finished this year, before the weather gets too bad and access to this part of the site becomes problematic. Once this work is complete the northern part of the site would be fully restored and would be able to put into agricultural use/aftercare.

Imported material, as detailed in the last monitoring report, is currently being deposited in areas 5a and 6a. As per the approved phasing the southern part of the site will be worked west to east, with the central haul road removed as part of the last phase. Depending on

how wet the winter is, the operator may use the aforementioned areas as a bit of a stockpiling area and then as the weather breaks this material would simply be spread further east to level.

It is understood that the operator is in discussions with the Environment Agency with regard to leachate levels from the landfill and that some optioneering in this regard is currently being undertaken. It was suggested that one option being considered was a treatment plant to which it was acknowledged planning permission would be required.
