Actions from last site visit:

- Approval of revised landscape and restoration scheme varying the approved miscanthus biomass crop to grassland comprising a BSH seed mix A15 landfill reclamation mix, similar to the existing belt of grassland surrounding the miscanthus plot.
- Continued general maintenance and grass cuts.
- Large rubble removed from around the site periphery.

Inspection Results Summary:

- Site profile was per the approved drawings.
- Large rubble around the site periphery has been removed.
- Gas extraction works ongoing with regard to gas wells/vents and pipes. Internal haul remains in use to facilitate gas extraction.
- Discussed possible submission of a solar panel application after previous application for the construction of ground mounted solar photovoltaic array development with associated fencing, access, storage containers and other associated infrastructure was withdrawn in 2021.
