Actions from last site visit: Remain as per the last 4 monitoring visit as well as the update comments.

- Height of site stockpiles to be maintained to their designated heights. Update: Kept on record as reminder.
- Stockpiling area only to be used for stocking purposes. Update: Still outstanding. Use of the land for screening purposes requires either to be regularised or for the machinery/plant to be removed. See appraisal.
- Tidying up of the plant/machinery parts located within the stockpiling area; concrete batching plant and north western corner on perimeter of site where lake float raft elements are stored now outside the fencing line whilst various other pieces of metal and blue plastic barrels now becoming engulfed as sand from the stockpile area is blown by the wind over the redundant items. Three large drainage pipes upended and located in sand stocking area. Update: Accumulations of redundant plant/machinery and odd items still stored in various points around site. This meeting (25/02/25) Bill Grovers anticipated that by the time of the next monitoring visit that the redundant items would have been cleared by a contractor. See appraisal.

Inspection Results Summary:

- Site bellmouth clean at time of visit.
- Site office/welfare block operational. As reported at last visit: Office location now comprises two offices; welfare block smaller storage unit nearest car park. Behind and within car park area are two long storage units. Various items including tyres/plastic container; concrete rubble and other small bits located around units and with the weed growth appear to have been there some time. Now a "hawk" bird scarer flying west of the welfare block. This appears to have scared off the Rooks who used to nest behind offices. BG asked to remove this immediately as birds are appearing not nesting in the immediate tree belt.
- Westward beyond the units the previously recorded stretch of ground clearance has now begun to vegetate over. The reason for the clearance remains unclear.
- AH noted the growth of the layered road side hedge and considered some further maintenance to be undertaken.
- Southern silt lagoon continues to expand its exposed silt. (Bill Groves who was met in his office at the end of the visit again as previous visit confirmed some sand being lifted and mixed with as dug. Longer commitment to removal and use of the silt appears still not clear.)
- Western void quiet. Conveyor line has relocated hopper feeder alongside the new Phase 6a/b workings. AH noted that latest idea to have a redesigned conveyor run to access into the current working Phase.
- Within the present excavation area (Phase 6a/b) 360 long reach excavator parked alongside the northern batter that has the retained trees above.
- Western side of site the boundary hedgerow still has its tree guards on. History of planting unclear although believed to have been undertaken as advance screening

of the quarry although the hedge appears to be on neighbouring land. Clearance of the guards would be beneficial.

- Combination of hedge and gorse growth now combining to overhang the gap between and prevent passage.
- Reinstated meadow full of Ox Eye daisy.
- Anticipated soil stripping of final Phase 8 will allow soil to be transferred to the western void to complete grading of levels. Buffer to be left around base of perimeter bunding whilst internal filling/grading of levels to be undertaken later in year.
- Water level in base of void with establishing vegetation above and below water level.
- Sand martins now in occupation of the western batter of future Phase 8.
- Transplanted trees and planted hedgerow plants along northern boundary viewed. Competition in the fenced hedgerow with thistle growth. Some strimming/maintenance would be beneficial.
- Small stockpiles of "as dug" sand in this working void area.
- Stockpiling of redundant items of miscellaneous nature continues its presence along the western/south western corner. 1 NMR liveried roll on container located south western corner. As previous visits there are 2 no Red Biffa ISO containers alongside the redundant items. Parts of the future bagging plant infrastructure which is scheduled for construction in this location remain stored on the land. A further welfare unit is sited further to the north.
- Some stockpiles of processed stone situated in north east corner of the stocking area.
- Old stocks of overburden/spoil/stocks remain in various mounds along the northern perimeter.
- Southern perimeter has screening unit and further stockpiles. Location and operation of this plant has been referenced previously and needs addressing.
- East of stocking area southern most former silt lagoon awaits some regrading works as central portion has sunk.
- Old silt lagoon to its north worked through to view where some removal of rushes appear to have taken place prior to the last monitoring visit although the reason unknown. Appears in the past the lagoon area had seen sand tipped into it along with silt.
- Eastern stockpiling area continues to accommodate a further sand stockpile approximately 3-4m metres high.
- East of the eastern stockpile has been stockpiled further redundant items comprising what appears to be the floating pump infrastructure.
- At time of starting visit 3 to 4 HGV's entering/leaving site. Site movements afterwards appeared quiet. One concrete batching vehicle parked next to concrete plant.
