Actions from last site visit:

Keeping the site entrance clear of mud/debris and confirmation as to procedures
to maintain this position. Update: Kept on for monitoring by operator At time
of visit the site entrance and crossover had tracking marks in the dusty
conditions.

- Completion of the cut off ditches and diversion/collection of surface water runoff from wet recycling area to prevent discharge into eastern copse and processing of the water. Update: Ditches still to be finalised. Eastern perimeter has Lego blocks demarcate the eastern site boundary.
- Planting up of the roadside bund this planting season. **Update: JB indicated** plans still awaited from utility company. No completion date anticipated.
- Removal of the general storage from car parking area adjacent industrial estate entrance on north side of road. Update: Carparking area cleaned and clear of items.
- Potential for erected visual height marker in stockpiling area alongside wet recycling plant. Update: Still not actioned. Action Point JB
- Clearance of remaining silt from haul road ditch. Update: Ditch had been cleared at last visit however it is now about half full of sediment again.
- CLEUD parcel regularising issues. Update: Still awaited. GM considering to get application submitted before end of September 2025. Delays appear to be around drainage aspects.
 - Reducing stockpile heights in dry recycling bay/topsoil stores in south western corner of the main void and levelling off the infill within the land fill cell to below the perimeter bund heights. Update: This appears to have been mostly carried out. However at time of visit waste in north eastern cell now well above surrounding ground level. This needs to be lowered as soon as possible.

Inspection Results

- Site entrance clear although road verges southwards along highway continued evidence of cutting in with tyre tracks. Tracing of vehicles evident across the highway crossing.
- Site footprint quiet regular stream of HGV's with what inerts being imported. Articulated HGVs serving the block making also entering site.

- Sand stockpiles in site low with the main processing yard now mostly occupied by stockpiles of processed gravel; sand and silt drying out. Stockpiles of inerts being fed into processing plant by 360 excavator.
- Sand stockpile near site entrance, largest of the on site stockpiles around 5- 8 metres high throughout.
- JB noted that most employees in office relocated to Crumps Farm. Main offices to be used as welfare block.
- Concrete batching plant operational
- Block making area active with about 12 rows of blocks curing. Previous stocking of blocks around the shed/maintenance block now mostly removed.

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- JB advised a lot of the machinery/spares being removed off site.
- Some Lego blocks remain on northern perimeter although the form work for these are stacked near the maintenance building.
- JB pointed out breaching and removal of silt from old lagoons on northern perimeter underway to enable the area to be reclaimed. JB not aware at present of future land use intentions once this area cleared.
- Mobile crusher parked up on processing yard in amongst the various stockpiles just north of the silt pressing plant.
- Wet recycling stockpile had its attendant excavator sitting atop the feed source material. Stockpile much larger than previous visit. Market appears to have been picking up. Height throughout of stockpile about 6 – 8 metres.
- Silt pressing bays half filled with processed silt awaiting removal. Ongoing wet material/silt stockpiles area to the north of the recycling area.
- Car park area adjacent industrial estate entrance clear of debris and tree protection barrier remains in place.
- South of the road the dry recycling area active with front loader servicing stocks.
 Stockpiles now reduced in quantity and footprint. Stockpile in north eastern corner well above perimeter bund height. JB advised this would be lowered by 12 noon.
 Excavator still working at level of surrounding permitter bund height and stockpile higher still. This needs to be lowered in height as well as wind picking up dust as material being moved.
- Western and central side of the recycling area taken up with the bays accommodating the processed pellets imported to the site. Central bay occupied by the pellets. GM to have the application in by end of September.
- Haul road to voids holding up well. Ditch on west previously cleaned out now holding about half of depth in silt and requires further clearing.
- Water bowser filling up from adjacent lagoon/pond.
- Excavation void has now opened out with remining mineral removed. And as
 reported eastern cell filled and above level of perimeter bund. Central cell 1b
 formed with base liner/gravel and up pipe in stalled. Cell 1c about half filled and
 awaiting raising of intermediate barrier to allow final filling to then allow haul road
 across the top for Western extension.

Actions to be taken before next site visit:

- Keeping the site entrance clear of mud/debris and confirmation as to procedures to maintain this position.
- Completion of the cut off ditches and diversion/collection of surface water runoff from wet recycling area to prevent discharge into eastern copse and processing of the water.
- Eastern site boundary of the wet recycling area needs to be in accordance with the approved site plan and the approved screening measures instigated. The

extent of the recycled material stockpiles outside of their permitted areas needs to be regularised through their removal and reduction in footprint.

- Planting up of the roadside bund this planting season.
- Potential for erected visual height marker in stockpiling area alongside wet recycling plant.
- CLEUD parcel regularising issues.
- Reducing stockpile heights in dry recycling bay/topsoil stores in south western corner of the main void and levelling off the infill within the land fill cell to below the perimeter bund heights.
- Clearance of the ditch along site haul road south of Slough Lane

Note: The actions noted in this report are required in order to ensure adequate progress is made and to avoid potential enforcement action against a breach of planning control.
