Actions from last site visit:

Replacement of damaged tree guards

Grass mowed and length maintained

Inspection Results Summary:

- Grassland mowed and harvested for hay.
- Pest prevention spray still being used around base of smaller trees.
- Sand faces and badger setts in correct place and maintained.
- Waterbody and surrounding margins well-maintained.
- Tree casings still on many trees. Some starting to split on bigger trees and will need to be removed. Others broken off and on the ground.
- Written agreement received committing to a rolling cycle of tree guard removal based on the size of the tree in question, with the guards being removed from the largest/most mature first. Will commence in the summer.
- Site has been restored in accordance with approved plans and has successfully completed its fifth year of aftercare, subject to the above removal of casings.

Actions to be taken before next site visit:

- Begin rolling cycle of tree casing removal.
- Continue to keep grass mowed.
